Steps to be taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled: Ventilate area of spill. Rinse spill down drain with enough water to dilute solution as directed. If no drain is available, wipe spill with disposable material. Use impervious gloves if cleanup is a prolonged process. Dispose of material outside of building, immediately.

Waste Disposal Method – Through regular drain systems with enough water to dilute solution as directed.

Precautions to be Taken in Handling and Storing: Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Store at room temperature, in well ventilated area. Do not store near food.
